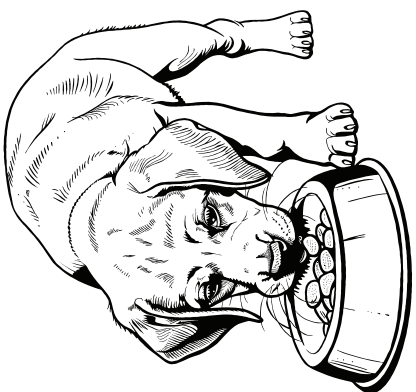


CHEWING A TOY OR BONE

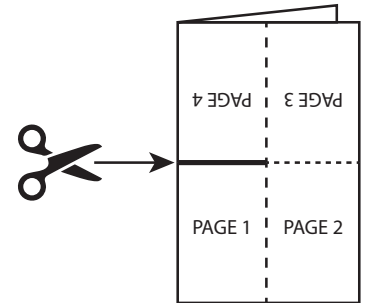

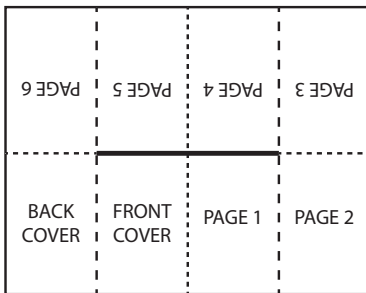
HAMBURGER FOLD



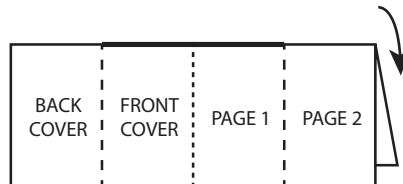
ACCORDION (FOLD THE
FLAPS BACK ON THEMSELVES)



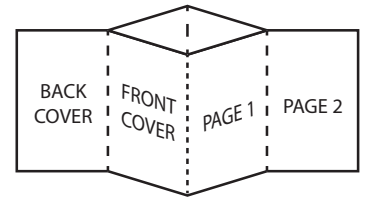
UNFOLD ACCORDION &

JUST TO THE MIDDLE



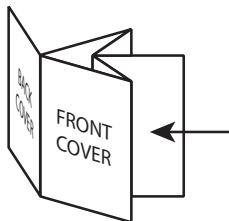
UNFOLD
